

- Chinuk Wawa Game Instructions -

1. Create groups of 3
2. Spread out the Chinuk Wawa Animal Cards face-up
3. Listen as the computer plays the Chinuk Wawa Animals video. Race your group members to pick up the picture card that matches the video.
 - a. For example: If the computer says “mawich”, race your group members to pick up the card with the picture of a deer.
4. If you pick up the wrong card, you must return it to the pile and the other students in your group have the opportunity to grab the correct card.
5. When you pick up the correct card, put the card face-down in front of you.
6. Continue this process until there are no more object cards.
7. Once all of the cards have been claimed, each student will go through their stack of cards and say the Chinuk Wawa word for each letter. If a student is unable to remember the word for the animal, another student can say the word and “steal” the card.
8. The student who is able to say the most words for the animal cards wins the game.
