Amendment A was duly approved rejected by a vote of 516 for and 63 against, and cast ballots

PROPOSED AMENDMENT CONSTITUTION OF THE CONFEDERATED TRIBE OF THE GRAND RONDE COMMUNITY OF OREGON

AMENDMENT NO. A

Proposed: ARTICLE V – MEMBERSHIP, Section 5, shall be amended to read as follows (changed text bold, underlined; removed text in strikeout):

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

- <u>Sec. 5.</u> <u>Loss of Membership.</u> The Tribal Council shall by ordinance prescribe rules and regulations governing involuntary loss of membership. The reasons for such loss shall be limited exclusively to failure to meet the requirements set forth for membership in this Constitution;
 - (a) Fraud. Any person who was enrolled as a result of fraud.
 - (b) <u>Dual Enrollment</u>. Any member who is enrolled as a member in any other federally recognized Indian tribe.

provided, that nNothing in this section shall prohibit a member from voluntarily relinquishing membership in the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon, with the consent of the Tribal Council.
